Frequently Asked Questions

***Q: Can we attend an in-person service every week?***

A: Worshippers are encouraged to attend service as often as they would like. Attendance registrations will help us know when we need to add a second service.

***Q: What happens if the registration is already full for a Sunday service?***

A: If the service capacity is already met, you can add yourself to the waitlist by texting “Waitlist” to (470) 634-4916 and following the prompts. Waitlisted worshippers will be added on a first-come-first-added basis as space becomes available.

***Q: Does the maximum capacity of 250 include the staff and volunteers?***

A: Yes. The maximum capacity is based upon everyone who will be in the sanctuary during service.

***Q: Can visitors/nonmembers attend the services?***

A: Absolutely. Guests are welcome and invited; however, they do need to register.

***Q: Can children attend the services?***

A: Yes. Children are allowed to attend the services. Just remember that we will not be offering nursery, children, or youth ministry onsite. Children who attend the service must be registered and seated in the sanctuary with an accompanying adult.

***Q: Do you require vaccination status to be disclosed in the registration?***

A: No. We are doing our best to protect the privacy of our worshippers. We also want to ensure that we do not create division between vaccinated people and those who cannot or have not yet chosen to.

***Q: How early do we have to arrive for the service?***

A: We recommend that you plan to arrive at least 15 minutes before service begins. This will give you time to have your temperature taken, complete your registration check-in, and be directed to your seat.

***Q: Will the check-in process take place outside the church building?***

A: No. Temperature checks and registration check-in will be completed in the main lobby.

***Q: What is the protocol for using the restrooms?***

A: All restrooms will be open and available.

***Q: Will there be another space in the building designated for overflow?***

A: We do not plan to designate overflow space in the building. When we see that we consistently reach our maximum seating capacity, we will add another service to accommodate more worshippers.
