

**Reset Your Faith**  
**Genesis 15:1-4 ESV**

<sup>1</sup>After these things the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision: “Fear not, Abram, I am your shield; your reward shall be very great.” <sup>2</sup>But Abram said, “O Lord God, what will you give me, for I continue childless, and the heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus?” <sup>3</sup>And Abram said, “Behold, you have given me no offspring, and a member of my household will be my heir.” <sup>4</sup>And behold, the word of the Lord came to him: “This man shall not be your heir; your very own son shall be your heir.”

Jesus said all things are possible to the one who believes (Mark 9:23). What God has for your future demands that you believe him now.

**DISPUTES (Genesis 13: 5-9)**
