Providential Purposeful Pruning

What You May Lose is Nothing When Compared to What You Stand to Gain

- Amaziah was concerned with what he paid for his troops.
- In life things will have expiration dates and you cannot keep people in life past their expiration date.
- Things you try to keep will cost you more than if you try to keep them.

The Lord is Able (v9)

- God will allow you to get back way more than what you have spent.

- Amaziah didn’t lose much compared to what God can give.
- If you let go of less you are positioning yourself for much, much more!
