

Ask the Right Questions Luke 10:25-37

Abandon what you've heard about the parable of the GOOD Samaritan. Samaritans, in general, were NOT bad.

Do you remember what it's like to be an outsider as Luke was?

"We are living, right now, in the age of the other." – Bishop Johnathan Alvarado

Everyone will not have discernment.

The Gospel is narrative in nature.

The devil wants to mute your story.

"...I know what it is for me." – Bishop Johnathan Alvarado

Avoid oversimplification of the Gospel.

Stop looking for one or two verses in the Bible that satisfy your situation.

"Oftentimes the question that comes out on the surface is not the real question." – Bishop Johnathan Alvarado

What does your reading of the Law say? Read the book for yourself.

Don't judge others by your own experience.

"The way we know you understand scripture is your life is transformed." – Bishop Johnathan Alvarado

Ask the right questions.
