

Disciples Multiply Disciples Matthew 28:18-20 (NKJV)

The Forward Conference has energized the youth of New Covenant.

GO, MAKE, BAPTIZE, TEACH is the charge Jesus gave to EVERYONE!

GO – Move with Purpose

- Not just for preachers, deacons, or ministry leaders—Jesus is talking to disciples. That means us
- Going isn't just about location, it's about intention.

“We've got to get out of these seats.” – Minister Bria Price

- Jesus' ministry was mobile. He didn't stay in Nazareth; He went out.

“Sometimes we are so down about what is attacking us that we forget to move...when God is telling us to move, He is not letting us go by ourselves.” – Minister Bria Price

- Going means stepping out of comfort zones and stepping into obedience.

Food for Thought: Where is God asking you to go this week? Physically? Spiritually? Emotionally?

MAKE – Multiply, Don't Just Add

- Jesus said to make disciples—not just gather followers or create fans.

“It's not about the see me, it's about the see Him.” – Minister Bria Price

- This is about transformation, not transaction.

Food for Thought: Who are you walking with right now? Who are you discipling—formally or informally?

BAPTIZE – Redirection

- Baptism is the outward expression of inward transformation.
- Repent
- Reflect
- Refreshing
- Decision that gives you Direction

“What if I didn’t get into the water?” - Minister Bria Price

TEACH – Build Believers, Not Just Moments

Teaching can be anywhere!

You can help change someone’s life.

- Teaching is how we sustain the journey—not just spark.
- 73% percent of Jesus’ time was spent with disciples. 46 events were spent with disciples that were recorded. 17 events with the masses.

Food for Thought: Who are we rubbing off on? Are we helping others go deeper in faith?

Closing: Commissioned and Covered

Jesus doesn't just send us—He goes with us: “And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” (Matthew 28:20)

Do not confuse proximity with presence.

Trust that the God who called you will equip you.
